Troncones and Majahua are peaceful and welcoming communities, but it's always good to stay informed, take basic precautions, and prepare your emergency plan and kit.

General

- Stay informed, follow local news, community groups, and listen to the radio.
- Register with your Embassy, save their emergency contact information.
- Prepare for Emergencies and Weather Events. Hurricane season is June-November.
- You can dial 911 for ambulance, fire, and police, but the local contacts below may be faster.

Cultural Awareness

- Learn basic Spanish.
- Build relationships with locals.
- Respect local customs & environment.
- Avoid displaying valuables, carrying excessive cash or multiple credit cards.

Crime

In the rare event of a crime, contact the local ejido Comisario.
